1. Send a teacher/student a Christmas card.
2. Send a teacher/student a birthday card.
3. Speak positively about other students.
4. Ask if you can pray at lunch.
5. Attend or organize a Youth Alive club (yausa.com).
6. Ensure that your Christian club is telling others about Christ.
7. Visit a student in the hospital.
8. Distribute copies of *The Book of Hope* (hisstory.org).
9. Give an *On Course* magazine to a friend.
10. Give Christian literature to those who do not know Christ.
11. Pray for other students.
12. Volunteer to be a student manager for a sports team.
13. Volunteer to serve at school functions.
14. Be respectful to school staff.
15. Be on time to class and turn things in on time.
16. Give your best in school and in after-school activities.
17. Hand out donuts before school.
18. Bring in The Seven Project (thesevenproject.com; thesevenproject.org).
19. Volunteer to bring oranges for a sports team.
20. Tutor other students.
21. Organize students to serve during a crisis.
22. Have the school choir sing or the band play at your church.
23. Sing a Christian song for choir.
24. Encourage teachers and students.
25. Write a verse next to your signature in other's year-books.
26. Be polite.
27. Offer to pray for your principal.
28. Read a Christian book during breaks.
29. Organize a Teacher Appreciation Week.
30. Invite other students to a special youth group activity.
31. Offer to show new students around school.
32. Each week hang a new memory verse in your locker.
33. Apologize when needed.
34. Forgive others.
35. Look for opportunities to share your faith.
36. Help raise money for special needs.
37. Organize a special day to appreciate janitors.
